Contest Information

- » There will be three separate categories with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner for each category.
- » The three categories are as follows:
 - A. Pasta
 - B. Desserts
 - C. Sandwiches (savory only, not dessert)
- » Only one recipe per person may be chosen for each category.
- » A maximum of 20 entries for desserts and 14 entries for sandwich and pasta categories will be chosen to bring to the contest for final judging on Wednesday, January 24th. Contest begins at 10 a.m. in the Zehnder's Snowfest Warming Tent.
- » Registration form and recipes must be postmarked by January 3, 2018.
- » Finalists will be notified by January 10, 2018.

Rules

1. A \$5 registration fee per category is required (non-refundable; make check payable to Zehnders Snowfest 2018).
2. Contestants must be a Michigan resident age 18 years or older at the time of entry.
3. All recipes must be the original work of contestant and not infringe on the property rights of any third party.
4. Recipes must include Michigan Apples (please include variety - no Granny Smith apples). Check MichiganApples.com for a complete list of Michigan Apple varieties.
5. Recipes must use Pioneer Sugar.
6. All entries must be postmarked by January 3, 2018.
7. The Grand Prize winner must use the same recipe as the "Signature Dish" for their category in the World Food Championships (WFC). Contestants are encouraged to be familiar with the WFC official competitor packet, which can be found at www.worldfoodchampionships.com.
8. Contestants chosen as semi-finalists must be present during the final contest and judging.
9. Semi-finalists must bring prepared entry for judging at Zehnder's of Frankenmuth on Wednesday, January 24, 2018.
10. Contestants must provide their own heat source/warming dish for contest. Panini makers and electric skillets are permitted for the sandwich category.
11. All food prep must be done by contestants only. No helpers are allowed in prep area.
12. Semi-finalists entries will be judged on appearance, taste and overall impression.
13. Winners chosen by highest scores. All results are unofficial until verified by Michigan Apple Committee.
14. All recipes become the property of Sponsors and will not be returned.
15. The Michigan Apple Committee may, in its sole discretion, disqualify any entry it determines violates any of these rules or is otherwise inconsistent with the positive image of the Sponsors.
16. Recipes and contestant images may be used by Sponsors with no further compensation.
