Michigan now has 17.6 million apple trees in commercial production, covering 38,000 acres on 850 family-run farms.

In 2024, Michigan Apple growers harvested an estimated 30.5 million bushels (1.28 billion lbs.) of apples. In 2023, growers harvested 31.9 million bushels of apples.
